

How to Save These Files

Click any filename in the list to open or download it. If the file opens in your browser instead of downloading, use one of the methods below to save it to your device.

Desktop Browsers

All browsers (simplest method) Right-click the filename link and choose **"Save link as..."** (the exact wording varies slightly by browser). Choose a location on your device and click Save.

Chrome / Edge If the file opens in a new tab, press **Ctrl+S** (Windows/Linux) or **⌘S** (Mac) to save it. Alternatively, click the download icon in the browser toolbar if one appears.

Firefox Right-click the link → **"Save Link As..."**. If the file has already opened, press **Ctrl+S** / **⌘S**.

Safari (Mac) Right-click (or Control-click) the link → **"Download Linked File"** or **"Download Linked File As..."** to choose the filename. Files go to your Downloads folder by default.

iPhone / iPad (Safari)

1. Tap and hold the filename link until a menu appears.
2. Tap **"Download Linked File"**.
3. The file saves to your **Files app** → **Downloads** folder.

If you don't see "Download Linked File": Tap the link to open the file, then tap the **Share** button (box with an arrow pointing up) and choose **"Save to Files"**.

Android

Steps vary by browser and device manufacturer.

Chrome for Android

1. Tap and hold the filename link.
2. Tap **"Download link"** from the menu that appears.
3. The file saves to your **Downloads** folder (accessible via the Files app).

Firefox for Android

1. Tap and hold the filename link.
2. Tap "**Save link**".

Samsung Internet

1. Tap and hold the filename link.
2. Tap "**Save link**".

After downloading, open your device's **Files** or **My Files** app and navigate to **Downloads** to find the saved file.

Tips

- Your browser may ask where to save the file, or it may go automatically to your **Downloads** folder — this depends on your browser settings.
- If a file opens as plain text or an image in the browser, you can still save it with **Ctrl+S** / **⌘S** on desktop, or via the Share menu on mobile.
- To change where Chrome saves files: go to **Settings** → **Downloads** and toggle on "Ask where to save each file before downloading."
